

DAY 1: MEET AT OR TAMBO - DEPART SA, DINNER

We meet at the Ethiopian Air Counter of O.R. Tambo International airport, Johannesburg at 14h00, Complete the necessary formalities, greet family and friends and depart for Tel Aviv at 17H00.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV - CAESAREA - MEGGIDDO - MT CARMEL - NAZARETH AND CANA - TIBERIUS (BREAKFAST ON BOARD & DINNER)

• We arrive in **Tel Aviv** at 07:05, where we are warmly greeted by our local agent.

We will visit:

- Caesarea: A historic town constructed by King Herod the Great along the beautiful Mediterranean coast. Here, we will explore the impressive Roman Amphitheatre.
- Megiddo: Famously referenced in the Book of Revelation as the site
 of the final battle, Armageddon.
- Mount Carmel: Known for the confrontation between the prophet Elijah and the prophets of Baal.
- Nazareth: Our day concludes with visits to Nazareth, the site of the Annunciation. Cana, known for the location of Jesus' first miracle.
 Time permitting, we can arrange for marriage vow renewals. There is no cost, but a donation to the church is welcomed.

Each stop offers a unique glimpse into the rich tapestry of biblical history, setting the tone for our spiritual journey.

We end the day with dinner at our hotel in **Tiberius**. **After dinner** – take a walk to the waterfront and flea market.

DAY 3: BEATITUDES - MENSA CHRISTI - TABGHA - GALILEE - MENSA CHRISTI - YARDENIT - CAPERNAUM (BREAKFAST & DINNER)


This morning after breakfast, we will meet our tour guide and group in the lobby.

- We will visit several significant biblical sites:
- Mount of Beatitudes: This serene location is where Jesus delivered the famous Sermon on the Mount. Matthew 5.
- Mensa Christi: Visit the site traditionally believed to be where Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection.
- Village of Magdala: We have the opportunity to see the remains of a first-century synagogue, offering a glimpse into the religious life during Jesus' time.
- Capernaum: We see St. Peter's House, and the impressive sixthcentury synagogue. Capernaum is often referred to as the "Town of Jesus" due to its significance in his ministry.
- Sea of Galilee: Take part in a memorable worship service while enjoying a peaceful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.
- Yardenit: This renowned Christian baptism site is on the Jordan River.
 Baptism or Re-dedication: For those interested, you can choose to participate in a baptism or re-dedication ceremony. The approximate cost for hiring a gown and using shower facilities is \$10.

We end the day with dinner at our hotel in **Tiberius**. **After dinner** – Join in a devotion session, reflecting on the day. Later take a walk to the waterfront and flea market.







DAY 4: BET SHEAN - JERICHO - THE DEAD SEA (BREAKFAST & DINNER)

This morning after breakfast, with packed bags, we will meet our tour guide and group in the lobby for our day tour.

We will visit:

- **Bet Shean:** A site renowned for its rich history and impressive archaeological remains. The bodies of Saul and his sons were fastened to its walls. (1 Kings 4:12).
- Jericho: Next, we travel to the historic city of Jericho. Here, we will
 ascend the Mount of Temptation via a cable car ride, offering
 breathtaking views of the wilderness and the Palm City.
- Ein Bokkek: After enjoying a delightful lunch, we'll head to our hotel.
 Upon arrival, you'll have the opportunity to unwind and experience the unique sensation of floating in the rejuvenating and salt rich waters of the Dead Sea. You are welcome to use the Spa facilities at the hotel.

DAY 5: MASADA - ENGEDI - QUMRAN - GALICANTU (BREAKFAST & DINNER)

This morning after breakfast, we will meet our tour guide and group in the lobby for our day tour.

We will visit:

- Masada: This ancient site offers breathtaking views and a deep connection to Israel's past.
- Engedi National Park: You can immerse yourself in the natural beauty and tranquillity of this oasis. When David fled from Saul, he hid in En Gedi among the rocks there (1 Samuel 23:29).
- Qumran: Next we will head to Qumran, where we can view the legendary Dead Sea Scrolls. Discover the fascinating history behind these ancient manuscripts and the community that once thrived here.
- Jerusalem: After lunch, we will travel to the iconic city of Jerusalem.
 Our first stop will be the Cockrow Church, also known as St. Peter in Galicantu. We see the dungeon where Jesus was held the night before His crucifixion.
- Mt Scopus: If time permits, we visit Mount Scopus to pray over the City.

We travel to our hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight stay.


After dinner, at your leisure, you can take a tram to Ben Yehuda street or visit the Old City.

DAY 6: MT. OF OLIVES - GETHSEMANE - MT. ZION - HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL (BREAKFAST & DINNER)

This morning after breakfast, we will meet our tour guide and group in the lobby for our day tour.

We will visit:

- Mount Of Olives: <u>Today we will wear our T-shirts for our group photo</u>. We walk down the **Palm Sunday Road**.
- Church of the Ascension: Discover the traditional site where Jesus is believed to have ascended to heaven.





DAY 6: CONTINUED

- We will visit:
- Pater Noster Church: Visit the church that commemorates the Lord's Prayer.
- Dominus Flevit: Reflect at the church built where Jesus is said to have wept over Jerusalem.
- Garden of Gethsemane: Walk through the serene garden that holds centuries-old olive trees, believed to have witnessed Jesus' agony.

This afternoon we will visit Mount Zion, home to:

- The Upper Room: See the traditional site of the Last Supper.
- Tomb of King David: See the memorial of the revered biblical king.
- Western Wall (Kotel): A profound spiritual experience in the Jewish Quarter. Also known as the wailing wall.

We then have a refreshing walk through **Hezekiah's Tunnel** in the **City** of **David**.

DAY 7: BETHESDA - VIA DOLOROSA - GARDEN TOMB - GOLGOTHA (BREAKFAST & DINNER)

This morning after breakfast, we will meet our tour guide and group in the lobby for our day tour.

We will visit:

- Pool of Bethesda: Today we visit the Pool of Bethesda, a site renowned for healing. Next we visit St. Anne's Church, with its remarkable acoustics.
- Via Dolorosa: Continue your journey by walking along this
 Protestant path, tracing the steps believed to have been taken by
 Jesus on his way to crucifixion. We visit the Lithostratos, an ancient,
 historical pavement.
- Church of the Holy Sepulchre: Later we visit this church, where some believe is the place of Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection.
- Garden Tomb: This afternoon, partake in a Communion service in a serene garden setting that offers a view of Golgotha, also known as the Place of the Skull as well as visit the Tomb of Jesus.
- Old City: Conclude your day with leisure time to explore the bustling markets and shops of the Old City. Soak in the vibrant atmosphere and discover unique souvenirs to commemorate your journey.

DAY 8: BET GUVRIN - VALLEY OF ELAH - BETHLEHEM (BREAKFAST & DINNER)

We will visit:

• Bet Guvrin Caves: We visit the caves and the Valley of Elah - the legendary site of the biblical battle between David and Goliath.





DAY 8: CONTINUED

- We will visit:
- Bethlehem: We then travel to Bethlehem to visit the Shepherds'
 Fields, where the announcement of Jesus' birth to the shepherds by the angels took place. Then, proceed to the Church of the Nativity, the revered birthplace of Jesus.
- ¶ Lunch is at your own expense ★ Suggestion The Grotto.

★ After dinner, take the opportunity to explore Ben Yehudah Street, a vibrant hub for last-minute shopping. Experience the lively atmosphere, browse unique shops, and perhaps pick up a few special souvenirs to remember your journey.

DAY 9: YAD VASHEM - EIN KAREM - JOPPA (BREAKFAST)

This morning is our last day. After breakfast, with packed bags, we will meet our tour guide and group in the lobby.

- We will visit:
- Temple Mount, located in the Muslim Quarter of the Old City of Jerusalem. Here, you will view the Al-Aqsa Mosque.
- Yad Vashem, the World Holocaust Remembrance Center. This
 museum offers a solemn reflection on the history and impact of the
 Holocaust, honouring the memory of those who perished.
- **Ein Karem**, known as the birthplace of John the Baptist is our next visit. This quaint village offers a serene atmosphere and a chance to explore its charming surroundings and historic sites.
- Joppa (Jaffa): On our way to the airport, we stop at the oldest harbour city in the world, where Jonah left for Tarshish from. (Jonah 1:3)

₹ At 18:30, we will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our departure. As we leave the **Holy Land**, we carry with us unforgettable experiences, memories and stories to share.

Overnight and meals on board.


DAY 10: ARRIVE BACK HOME (MEALS ON BOARD)
